Instructions for the Toledo Buffalo Soldiers MC 2019 DreamMaker Scholarship

The Toledo Buffalo Soldiers Motorcycle Club, Inc. is a chartered chapter of the National Association of Buffalo Soldiers and Troopers Motorcycle Clubs (NABSTMC). The philosophy of the NABSTMC and its many chapters across the country are;

- To promote the history of African American Veterans.
- To be a positive role model for youth in our Community.
- To support our veterans by visiting local Veterans, their families, and supporting our fallen Hero's.
- To support Charitable Organizations in our Community.
- To uphold the traditions and standards of the National Association of Buffalo Soldiers and Troopers Motorcycle Club.
- To promote Motorcycle Safety in our Community.

The Toledo Buffalo Soldiers Motorcycle Club, Inc. will be awarding two (2) \$500.00 and one (1) \$1,000.00 scholarships to qualified 2019 graduating high school seniors. The scholarship funds will be disbursed by the Toledo Buffalo Soldiers Motorcycle Club, Inc. to the three (3) scholarship recipients, upon verification that he or she has been accepted and enrolled at a college of higher learning. Graduating high school seniors with a GPA of 2.5 or greater, who have been admitted to college, will be eligible to apply. The scholarship will be awarded based on the standing of the candidate in relation to other competitors based on overall qualifications, with the most weight focused on the quality of the final essay.

Instructions for candidates:

- (1) Prepare a letter of introduction, identifying yourself, your accomplishments to date and the degree you are seeking. Provide a brief summary of how you plan to use the scholarship funding if selected.
- (2) Provide at least two letters of recommendation from an educator or business professional; written on official letterhead.
- (3) Write a 500 word essay, typewritten in Arial or Times New Roman, 12 font, with 1" margins and paragraphs double spaced in your own words on two (2) of the following topics:
 - A. Write in detail; "In What Ways Does the 9th & 10th Buffalo Soldier Cavalry's legacy inspires you and why is it necessary that we pass on their legacy for future generations."
 - B. The stories of the 9th & 10th Cavalry Buffalo Soldiers exemplify many positive character traits. Please provide examples of these character traits from the lives of Buffalo Soldiers and write in detail how two (2) of these character traits can be used to help mold or develop your life.
 - C. The Congressional Medal of Honor is presented to the recipient by the President of the United States. Write on one (1) of the Buffalo Soldiers awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor, what can be learned from his life, and about their efforts and commitment to duty the recipient exhibited.
 - D. What are your dreams, hopes, and aspirations or what are your intentions upon graduation from college? How do your dreams, hopes, or aspirations reflect those of the 9th and 10th Cavalry Buffalo Soldiers?
- (4) Submit your information and essay by ****May 1, 2019****.
